We are glad to invite the representatives of your Agency's management to an information seminar dedicated to the topics of Polish Higher Education, Polish-Kazakh student exchange and certification of recruiting agencies. The seminar is to take place on September 8, 2017 in Astana and is being organized by "Perspektywy" Education Foundation alongside with Commission for International Cooperation of the Conference of Rectors of Academic Schools in Poland (CRASP) – in cooperation with Independent Kazakh Agency for Quality Assurance in Education. Polish Diplomatic Authorities have also been invited to take part in the meeting.
